## ANTI-RAGGING POLICY

*(In accordance with UGC Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009 and subsequent UGC advisories)*

---

### 1. PREAMBLE

Smt. Indira Gandhi PG College, a degree college affiliated to **Maharaja Suhel Dev State University, Azamgarh**, is firmly committed to maintaining a safe, inclusive, disciplined, and learner-friendly academic environment where every student is treated with dignity, fairness, and respect.

The institution recognizes that ragging, in any form, is a serious violation of human dignity, personal liberty, and institutional discipline. It adversely affects the physical, psychological, emotional, and academic well-being of students, particularly newly admitted learners.

The College adopts a **zero-tolerance policy** towards ragging and undertakes comprehensive preventive, monitoring, corrective, and punitive measures to ensure that all students can pursue their education without fear, intimidation, coercion, or humiliation.

This Anti-Ragging Policy provides a structured framework to:

- Prevent incidents of ragging
- Create awareness among students, parents, faculty, and staff
- Establish effective mechanisms for vigilance and grievance redressal
- Ensure prompt and strict disciplinary action against offenders

The policy reflects the institution's commitment to ethical conduct, student welfare, campus safety, and holistic development and is binding on all members of the college community.

### 2. APPLICABILITY

## 2.1 Students

This policy applies to **all students** enrolled in Smt. Indira Gandhi PG College, including undergraduate, postgraduate, and any other programmes offered by the institution.

## 2.2 Campus and Institutional Premises

The policy is applicable to all spaces owned, managed, or utilized by the College, including:

- Classrooms, laboratories, libraries, seminar halls
- Corridors, common areas, washrooms
- Playgrounds, sports and activity areas
- Canteen, parking zones, transport facilities
- Administrative offices and allied premises

## 2.3 Off-Campus Activities

The policy extends to:

- Educational tours, field visits, internships, training programmes
- Cultural, sports, extension, and co-curricular activities
- Any accommodation or facility arranged or approved by the College

## 2.4 Modes of Interaction

Ragging through any medium is covered, including:

- Face-to-face interactions
- Written communication
- Digital platforms, social media, messaging apps, emails

The policy remains effective from the date of admission until the completion of the student's association with the institution.

## 3. DEFINITION OF RAGGING

Ragging refers to any conduct by an individual or group that causes or is likely to cause physical harm, psychological distress, humiliation, fear, or degradation to another student.

**Includes but is not limited to:**

### 3.1 Verbal and Non-Verbal Abuse

- Teasing, mocking, insulting

- Derogatory remarks on appearance, gender, caste, religion, region
- Threatening or intimidating behavior

### **3.2 Physical Acts**

- Forcing physical activities causing discomfort
- Hitting, pushing, restraining
- Acts endangering safety

### **3.3 Psychological Harassment**

- Causing fear, anxiety, trauma
- Social exclusion or manipulation
- Undermining dignity or confidence

### **3.4 Compulsion and Coercion**

- Forcing embarrassing or degrading acts
- Imposing rituals or punishments
- Pressuring disclosure of personal details

### **3.5 Academic Disruption**

- Obstructing attendance or examinations
- Interfering with studies

### **3.6 Financial Exploitation**

- Demanding money, gifts, services
- Forcing expenses

### **3.7 Sexual Misconduct**

- Unwelcome verbal/physical conduct of sexual nature

### **3.8 Cyber Ragging**

- Online harassment or threats
- Circulation of offensive content
- Public shaming or impersonation

Any such act, on or off campus, shall be treated as ragging.

---

## **4. PREVENTIVE MEASURES**

#### 4.1 Awareness & Sensitization

- Display of anti-ragging notices
- Orientation for new students on:
  - Institutional values
  - Rights and responsibilities
  - Legal consequences
- Sessions for seniors on responsible conduct

#### 4.2 Student Support

- Faculty mentoring system
- Counseling facilities
- Regular interaction to detect early concerns

#### 4.3 Monitoring

- Vigilance teams and surprise checks
- Extra supervision during:
  - Admission period
  - Initial academic weeks
  - Events and festivals

#### 4.4 Infrastructure

- CCTV at strategic locations
- Adequate lighting and security

#### 4.5 Participation

- Involvement of faculty, staff, students
- Confidential reporting culture

### 5. INSTITUTIONAL MECHANISMS

#### 5.1 Anti-Ragging Committee

##### Composition

- Principal – Chairperson
- Senior faculty members
- Non-teaching staff representative
- Student representatives
- Parent representative

- External member (if required)

### **Functions**

- Oversee implementation
- Review preventive actions
- Examine complaints
- Recommend disciplinary action
- Submit periodic reports

### **5.2 Anti-Ragging Squad**

- Conduct inspections
- Immediate response to complaints
- First-level inquiry
- Report to Committee

### **5.3 Mentoring System**

- Faculty-guided mentoring
- Promotion of healthy peer relations

---

## **6. DUTIES OF STUDENTS**

Students shall:

- Abide by this policy
- Submit anti-ragging undertakings
- Refrain from ragging
- Report incidents promptly
- Cooperate in inquiries

Good-faith reporters shall be protected from retaliation.

---

## **7. DUTIES OF FACULTY & STAFF**

Faculty and staff shall:

- Maintain vigilance
- Intervene immediately
- Guide and counsel students
- Assist inquiries

- Participate in awareness programmes

Negligence may invite administrative action.

---

## 8. DISCIPLINARY ACTION

Depending on gravity:

- Written warning
- Suspension from classes
- Withholding privileges
- Hostel expulsion
- Cancellation of admission
- Rustication/expulsion
- Legal action

Collective punishment may apply in group cases following natural justice.

---

## 9. COMPLAINT REDRESSAL

### 9.1 Nodal Officer

A designated Nodal Officer shall receive complaints. Details will be displayed on notice boards and website.

- Anti-Ragging Squad/Committee
- Principal
- Grievance cell

### 9.3 Confidentiality

- Identity protection
- No victimization

### Constitution of Anti-Ragging Squad

---

#### 1. PREAMBLE & PURPOSE

Smt. Indira Gandhi PG College is committed to providing a **safe, dignified, disciplined, and student-friendly academic environment** where every learner can pursue education without fear, intimidation, humiliation, or harassment.

As part of its proactive approach towards student welfare, campus safety, and institutional discipline, the College hereby constitutes an **Anti-Ragging Squad** as an operational, vigilance-oriented, and first-response body.

The Anti-Ragging Squad functions as the **primary preventive and responsive mechanism** to monitor, deter, and immediately address any behaviour that may compromise the safety, dignity, or mental well-being of students. The Squad works in close coordination with the College Administration and the Anti-Ragging Committee to ensure:

- Early identification of vulnerable situations
- Prompt intervention in suspected incidents
- Systematic reporting and documentation
- Creation of a ragging-free campus culture

---

#### 2. OBJECTIVES OF THE ANTI-RAGGING SQUAD

The Anti-Ragging Squad shall function with the following objectives:

1. To maintain a **safe, respectful, and inclusive** campus environment for all students
  2. To exercise **active vigilance** in areas and time periods vulnerable to ragging
  3. To act as the **first-response team** in cases of reported or suspected incidents
  4. To discourage misconduct through **visible presence, supervision, and monitoring**
  5. To promote **positive peer interaction, discipline, and institutional values**
  6. To ensure **fact-based observation, reporting, and documentation** for institutional review and action
- 

### 3. CONSTITUTION OF THE SQUAD

The Anti-Ragging Squad shall be constituted by the **Principal, Smt. Indira Gandhi PG College** and shall include balanced representation from academic, administrative, and student stakeholders to ensure effective campus coverage.

#### Composition

- Senior Faculty Member – **Convener**
- Faculty Member – **Member**
- Administrative / Non-Teaching Staff – **Member**
- Hostel Warden / Transport In-charge – **Member**
- Student Mentor / Peer Leader – **Member**

The composition of the Squad may be **reviewed and reconstituted periodically** by the competent authority to ensure operational effectiveness and adequate representation.

---

### 4. FUNCTIONS & DUTIES OF THE SQUAD

The Anti-Ragging Squad shall perform the following duties on a continuous and need-based basis:

## 4.1 Surveillance & Monitoring

Conduct regular and surprise checks in:

- Classrooms, laboratories, and libraries
- Canteens, corridors, and common areas
- Entry/exit points and transport facilities
- Hostels and residential areas (where applicable)

## 4.2 Event & Activity Supervision

Monitor:

- Student gatherings and informal interactions
- Cultural programmes and sports events
- Co-curricular and extracurricular activities

Remain especially active during:

- Admission periods
- Initial months of the academic session
- College events, festivals, and excursions

## 4.3 Response & Reporting

- Receive and record any instance or suspicion of ragging
- Ensure **immediate intervention** to prevent escalation
- Report all cases promptly to the Anti-Ragging Committee
- Maintain daily observation and vigilance logs, particularly during the first three months of the session

#### 4.4 Awareness Role

- Assist in student sensitization programmes
  - Promote mutual respect and healthy campus culture
  - Encourage responsible peer behaviour
- 

### 5. REPORTING & ACCOUNTABILITY

- The Anti-Ragging Squad shall function under the **overall supervision of the Anti-Ragging Committee** of the College.
- All findings and reports submitted by the Squad shall be:
  - Reviewed by the Anti-Ragging Committee
  - Placed before the Principal for necessary action
- Corrective and preventive measures shall be implemented based on recommendations arising from Squad reports.

#### 5.1 Record Maintenance

Records of Squad activities including:

- Inspection registers
- Observation logs
- Incident reports

shall be:

- Properly documented
- Preserved as institutional records

- Made available for internal and external inspection, NAAC review, and statutory assessment.
- 

## 6. VALIDITY

This Constitution of the Anti-Ragging Squad shall remain in force until revised or reconstituted by the competent authority of **Smt. Indira Gandhi PG College (Affiliated to Maharaja Suhel Dev State University, Azamgarh)** in accordance with UGC Regulations, university directives, and applicable statutory guidelines.

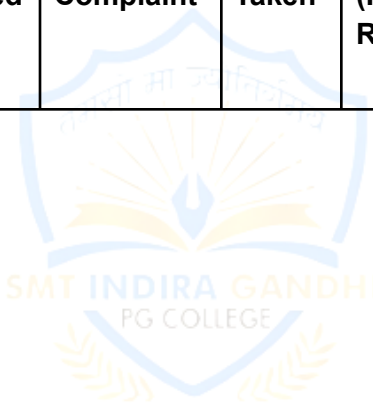
